## Extra-Curricular Sporting Opportunities

In order to support your child's physical, social and emotional wellbeing, we are now in a position where we can start to offer some extracurricular sporting opportunities.

We are aiming to restart some of these in the week beginning 28<sup>th</sup> September. There will of course be some changes in how these are run given the current situation and I would like to clarify some of these with you:

- Activities will take place within year group bubbles. On the very rare occasions where this cannot happen due to numbers, parental permission will be sought for a small number of students to mix with a different year group. In this situation a register will be taken so that we can easily trace these students if necessary. However, I must stress that these would be small and consistent groups in line with current government advice and only on rare occasions where there is no alternative.
- Other than that, students will continue to follow the current PE arrangements which have successfully been in place for the past few weeks. Students are collected from their bubble holding zones by the teacher in charge. Students will need to sanitise their hands before and after the activity. Social distancing is to be observed where at all possible whilst playing sport.
- We will continue to follow school, government and national governing body advice when running activities, many of which will have to be adapted in order to allow us to deliver them. Activities will be delivered outdoors where at all possible so we suggest bringing suitable clothing.
- We have a system in place for thoroughly sanitising all equipment used during the activity.
- The changing rooms remain unavailable for use therefore students may wear their PE kits to and from school on the days where they have an extra-curricular club.

We look forward to welcoming your child back into extracurricular sport.
