I am sure you will appreciate they exist to ensure that we all do everything we reasonably can for the safety of everyone. **They will be very strictly enforced, as will sanctions of being sent home and exclusions for students not working with us.**

Please do take the time to read and discuss the Behaviour Policy together very carefully as it involves many changes that are the result of Covid-19 and how we can all do our best to make school as safe as is reasonably possible for all of our community.

I do hope that you can see that our new approaches to Behaviour have been created to reassure everyone that we are doing our best to make school as safe as reasonably possible for all of our community, whilst also providing valuable learning experiences.
