

St Peter's Remote Education Process and Guidance for Parents and Carers

At St Peter's we will continue to provide **pre-recorded** lessons which have 'live' (not necessarily real time) footage of us either talking or visually presenting in the video. This blends the best of both worlds whilst still providing flexibility to students, teachers and parents.

For St Peter's in the event of any additional restrictions being implemented:

- Remote lessons will continue to be set using google classroom, building on work completed during in-school face to face lessons.
- Lessons will continue to use google classroom **assignments** wherever possible so that students can easily hand in work and teachers can gauge progress and provide purposeful feedback.
- We will continue to provide **pre-recorded** lessons which have 'live' (not necessarily real-time) footage of us either talking or visually presenting in the video.
- All pre-recorded lessons for year groups engaging in remote learning will be uploaded to google classroom **no later than** the start of the timetabled lesson and in most cases the start of the day.
- Lessons do not need to be completed in the order of students' timetables but we recommend trying to stick to this routine wherever possible.
- Teachers will be available in the google classroom during the hour of the timetabled lesson in order to ensure that everyone is able to access and understand the lesson content.
- Set tasks in lessons will take the equivalent length of time to complete to those set in school.
