Following the government announcement on Wednesday 30th December, I can now update you with the latest changes for the start of the Spring Term.

Monday 4th January

- As previously mentioned this will be a non-student day in order for staff to be trained and build on the planning for mass testing and remote learning that has already taken place during the Christmas holidays.

Tuesday 5th January

- School will now be open on site to all key critical worker and vulnerable students in all year groups but **NOT** to all Year 11 students as previously communicated.
- Please enter the school by your now usual year group bubble entrances.
- Please remember to bring your face mask and hand sanitiser to keep yourself and others as safe as possible.

All students not in school from Tuesday 5th January will be expected to attend their usual timetabled lessons remotely from 8.30am with their tutor until they are allowed back in school as per government guidance.

Monday 11th January

- All of year 11 will be expected in school along with all key critical worker students and vulnerable students.

Monday 18th January

- All students in all year groups will be expected in school.

1. Please do complete the consent form for the Covid Testing which was sent prior to Christmas if you wish to have this test when it becomes available. Consent Form is also attached to this email communication (both word and pdf).
2. Please do confirm with us if you are needing to update us with being a key critical worker or vulnerable student.
